John Stratford Smith

1930-1996



John Smith was known to most Lincolnshire people as 'mine host' at the Morning Star, Greetwell Gate, Lincoln. He was born in the pub and succeeded his father as licensee. His residence there lasted some 60 years.

Those who knew him well will know of his wide interest in the antique market, and in items associated with Lincoln. He had a particular love for small silver pieces and Lincoln pictures, a good many of which were bought from the salerooms of Thos Mawer & Son over the years. He was Custos Thesauri of the treasures of Lincoln Cathedral and a Trustee of the Usher Art Gallery.

It was John's wish that the Usher Art Gallery should benefit from his collection, and they have selected a number of paintings and silver items which will be displayed from time to time at the Gallery.

The remaining items will be offered for sale on 30th April and are described in this catalogue.

(This catalogue does of course contain the property of other owners, but the auctioneers will indicate to anyone particularly interested in John's items, those which are from his estate.)
