2. The full purchase money of each lot together with 5% **commission** in addition shall be paid to the Auctioneer on the fall of the hammer (if required). Each lot at the fall of the hammer shall be at the sole risk and expense of the purchaser, and shall be paid for and removed at his own risk and expense by the evening of the Sale, but no lot shall become the property of the purchaser or be removable until paid for, and if taken away in contravention of these conditions without an order for removal issued by the Auctioneer, the Auctioneer may recover either the lots or price thereof (at his option) by action of law.
