DESCRIPTIONS

Every effort is made to ensure the accuracy of the description of each lot but these whether made orally or in the catalogue are expressions of opinion and not representations of fact. No employee of the Auctioneers has any authority to make any representation of fact and the Auctioneers disclaim on behalf of the Vendor and themselves responsibility for authenticity, age, origin and condition and for accuracy of measurement or weight of any lot or lots.

MISREPRESENTATION

If within fourteen days after the sale the Auctioneers receive from the Purchaser notice in writing that in his view the lot is a deliberate forgery, and within seven days after such notification the Purchaser returns the lots to the Auctioneers in the same condition as prevailed at the time of sale and satisfies the Auctioneers that (having regard to the entry in the catalogue) the same is a deliberate forgery, then the Auctioneers shall be entitled to rescind the sale and to refund to the purchaser the purchase price of that lot. In deciding whether or not the lot is a deliberate forgery the Auctioneers shall be entitled at their discretion and at the cost of the Vendor to seek the views of any expert or other authority.

BIDDING
