



The Auctioneers will not be responsible for any loss, damage or injury occasioned to or sustained by any person during the period of public viewing and the auction sale howsoever the same may arise, unless arising from the negligence of any employee of the Auctioneers.

### APPLYING TO PURCHASERS

#### DESCRIPTIONS

Every effort is made to ensure the accuracy of the description of each lot but these whether made orally or in the catalogue are expressions of opinion and not representations of fact. No employee of the Auctioneers has any authority to make any representation of fact and the Auctioneers disclaim on behalf of the Vendor and themselves responsibility for authenticity, age, origin and condition and for accuracy of measurement or weight of any lot or lots.

#### MISREPRESENTATION

If within fourteen days after the sale the Auctioneers receive from the Purchaser notice in writing that in his view the lot is a deliberate forgery, and within seven days after such notification the Purchaser returns the lots to the Auctioneers in the same condition as prevailed at the time of sale and satisfies the Auctioneers that (having regard to the entry in the catalogue) the same is a deliberate forgery, then the Auctioneers shall be entitled to rescind the sale and to refund to the purchaser the purchase price of that lot. In deciding whether or not the lot is a deliberate forgery the Auctioneers shall be entitled at their discretion and at the cost of the Vendor to seek the views of any expert or other authority.

#### BIDDING

1. PURCHASERS ARE DEEMED TO HAVE SATISFIED THEMSELVES AS TO THE CONDITION OF ANY LOTS BEFORE BIDDING.
2. No bid may be withdrawn and the Auctioneers may refuse any bidding.
3. The Auctioneers may divide, combine, add to or withdraw any lots and shall determine the advance of each bid and may bid on behalf of the vendor on lots on which there is a reserve price.
4. The highest bidder shall be the buyer. If a dispute arises the Auctioneers have discretion to settle the dispute or to re-offer the lots. At the fall of the hammer the lots shall be at the sole risk of the purchaser who shall give to the Auctioneers his full name and address and such deposit as the Auctioneers may require.
5. The purchaser shall pay to the Auctioneers commission at the rate of 5% of the purchase price on each and every lot purchased.




